In this two-day, hands-on workshop, you will work closely with Jason aka Valbjorn to learn his miniature sculpting techniques.

Lessons will include:

- Techniques for working with putty on a fine scale
- Explore epoxy putty types and optimal mixing ratios for specific applications
- Lessons in sculpting hair and beards
- Learn to create and compose your own accessories like necklaces, pelts, and straps.

This workshop will dispel the mysteries of epoxy putty (Greenstuff/Milliput/Magic Sculpt/Tamiya) and empower you to explore the realm of customizing your miniatures.



What I will bring:

Epoxy Putty

Hand-made bamboo picks for hair sculpting (you get to keep!)

Hand-made sculpting tools for use during class (further details after ticket purchase)

Clay Shapers

Parchment Paper

Warhammer head and torso for you to sculpt hair on (you keep after class)

What you need:

Size 0-1 brush with a nice pointed tip
Size 0-1 worn brush you don't care so much about
Hobby Knife

Lamp

Bring a figure for us to add accessories to, like pelts, necklaces, etc. It doesn't have to be a Warhammer figure, but Warhammer scale is preferred. Something about the size of a space marine, sci-fi or fantasy will work. It's best if it's unpainted, but if you only have painted models, it will also work.

Optional: Bring your own sculpting tools for familiarity

Optional: Small glass palette or something flat and clean, like a smooth ceramic tile

I look forward to meeting and working with you all! This will be my first time visiting Germany, and I couldn't think of a better way, doing what I love.
